#### **BE SMART-BE SAFE LOCK YOUR DOORS**

The Christmas season always brings out a rash of vehicle and home burglaries. Don't give thieves an advantage by leaving items visible in your vehicles. Lock your doors at home and in your cars.

#### **SCHOOL BUS SAFETY**

With School back in full swing this seems like a good time to remind everyone about traffic laws as they relate to school busses. Here is a quick rundown of what you need to know.

- When a school bus is traveling down the road without any of its flashing lights on all normal traffic protocols apply.
- When a school bus has its amber lights flashing it is preparing to stop at a bus stop. Other drivers on the road, regardless of their direction of travel, should slow and prepare to stop but may still pass the bus at a speed no greater than 20 mph.
- When the bus is stopped and has red lights flashing all other vehicles on the road must stop too regardless of their direction of travel. There are a couple of exceptions to this:
  - When the bus is stopped at an intersection controlled by stop signs or a police officer directing traffic vehicles may pass the bus according to the right of way determined by the intersection, however, cross walk laws still apply.
  - When the road way is five lanes wide or wider and the bus is traveling in the opposite direction vehicles may pass in that farthest lane away from the bus.
  - When the bus is traveling in the opposite direction and the road way is divided by a continuous median vehicles may continue.

In Enoch City we don't have any road ways that meet these last two exceptions so if you are on the city streets and you come across a school bus with its red lights flashing you should stop and wait unless you happen to be at an intersection, then you still have to wait at that intersection for the kids to be out of the street before continuing. Failure to comply may result in a citation with the cost of \$100 or more. Thank you for your assistance in keeping the citizens of this great city safe. Cpl. M. Laub-Enoch PD

#### **SNOW REMOVAL POLICY**

When two (2") of snow has accumulated on the roads the plows are activated. The school bus routes are plowed first followed by the main roads and then the neighborhood streets. Please watch the weather and remove cars from the road ways so the plows can make a clean sweep. The plows will not come into cul-de-sacs if cars are parked on the road. Please remind your neighbors of this.
