Local elections in the past have been decided by just a few votes so let your voice be heard. All precincts vote at the City Office!!!!

## **EARLY VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT**

Prior to the regular election and before August 9<sup>th</sup> you may vote early by using an absentee ballot. Please come to the City Office to fill out the application and receive your ballot which you will mail to the County Clerk's Office. No ballots will be given out after 1:00pm on Fri. Aug 9<sup>th</sup>.

## **PUBLIC HEARING ON AUGUST 7<sup>th</sup> "TRUTH IN TAXATION"**

The Enoch City Council will hold a public hearing in their regular meeting at 6:00pm on August 7<sup>th</sup>. The public hearing is for the purpose of taking public comments on the increase in property taxes.
