ENOCH DOG LICENSES ARE DUE IN MARCH

All dog licenses are up for renewal in March. Please bring proof of current rabies shot and spay/neuter from your vet. Cost is \$10 if spayed/neutered and \$35 if not. If you have not registered your dog in the past you are required by law to do so. Enoch Animal Control call Dispatch 586-9445.

ENOCH ELEMENTARY KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Enoch Elementary School will be holding Kindergarten registration for the 2013-2014 school year on March 15, 2013 from 12:00 to 3:00pm in the school gymnasium. Children must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2013 to enroll. All enrolling students will need an official State Birth Certificate, Social Security number/card and a complete immunization record. Hearing and vision screenings will be available during registration. Please plan an hour to complete the registration process.

2013 CONSERVATION TREE PROGRAM

The Iron County Extension Service is offering trees and bushes at greatly reduced prices. Orders must be placed by April 1, 2013. CERT (Community Emergency Response Team)

CERT (Community Emergency Response Team) is a training program that prepares you to help yourself, your family and your neighbors in the event of a disaster. By getting trained in CERT you will have the skills to help emergency responders save lives and property. Enoch CERT is currently recruiting volunteers to be prepared to respond to their community in a disaster situation and to render assistance until emergency responders can arrive. As a member of a CERT team you can respond to disasters, participate in drills and exercises and take additional life-saving training. Enoch CERT meets once a month on the 3rd Thursday at 7:00pm.
