A MESSAGE FROM OUR MAYOR

This is an unprecedented time of economic and social concerns and the unknown can lead to fear. Here in Enoch City, we encourage all to seek the best information to protect you and your family. We are coordinating with local officials in Iron County and Cedar City and monitoring the information given to us by State official sources. If there is something you need to know, we will do our best through emergency management releases and social media to keep you informed. Our local efforts include plans to make sure that your homes continue to have fresh water, the garbage is picked up on time, and public safety concerns including police and fire protection are readily available. The strength of our community that sets us apart is the ability and willingness to come together in times of trial and hardship. Coming together does not mean exposing ourselves to illness, but that we can respond to physical and emotional needs as friends. If you are feeling stress, look for ways to help your neighbor. There is truth in the old adage of losing yourself in the service of others that gives you peace and calm. Make a phone call, a text, a social media message, or yell across the fence and seek ways to give.

DRIVE THROUGH EASTER EGG HUNT

In light of the CDC's recommendations on social distancing, the Enoch Police Department's Annual Easter Egg Hunt will be a drive-through this year. This will take place on Monday, April 6th beginning at 6:00pm until 7:00pm. Residents will drive through the north side of the City Office building driveway where the Easter Bunny will be handing out an Easter bag for each child in the vehicle –as long as supplies last. This is for children ages 0-11.

T-BALL/COACH PITCH SIGN-UPS ARE APRIL 1st TO APRIL 24th

Sign-ups will start Monday April 1st. Cost is \$35 per child. Apply and pay online at cityofenoch.org/events. You can also get the form at the City Office and pay the fee there. The fee includes a hat and t-shirt. There will be a \$10 late fee after April 24th. Games are scheduled for Tuesdays and Thursdays in the month of June. Ages 5 to 7 for T-Ball and 8-11 for Coach Pitch.

ENOCH CLEAN-UP AND BEAUTIFICATION WEEKENDS

The weekends of Friday and Saturday April 17th & 18th and April 24th & 25th the dumpsters at the City Maintenance Yard located at 4854 N. 600 E. will be open from 8:00am to 5:00pm. We are encouraging neighbors to help neighbors with yard clean up and encouraging scouts and other church groups to do service projects to help clean up Enoch City. If you have a pick-up truck and can help your neighbors haul trash it will be a great service.

OPEN BURNING IS ALLOWED THROUGH MAY 1st 

The Fire Department has approved the burn season this year from now through May 1st. You are required to call the Fire Department before you light your fire so they don't come out if called due to smoke. **586-2964**. No burning on windy days and please be prepared with your hose and shovels to completely extinguish your fire.

WATER CONSERVATION TIP 

It is time to check your sprinkler systems to get ready for watering season. Winter freezes can cause broken sprinkler lines so watch for soggy or extra green spots and check for broken pipes. In early spring, set sprinklers for once per week and turn them off if it rains. Saving water is essential in our desert area.

NOXIOUS WEEDS 

Spring is here, with intermittent winter spurts and the plants around us will start growing. Some enhance our views while others create problems. It is every landowner's responsibility to keep their land clean and free from "noxious weeds". The most prevalent "noxious weeds" in our area are thistle and white top. If you see these in Enoch City or have any questions, please call the City Office at 435-586-1119. Cutting them down and disposing of them would be of the greatest service.

The City dumpsters are available during regular business hours Monday through Thursday- We close at 12:30pm on Friday. No construction waste may be dumped.
