The Enoch City Council meets on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of each month at 6:00PM. **Except for the meeting scheduled for January 1<sup>st</sup>, New Year's Day, which will be held on 1-8-2020.**

The Planning Commission meets on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of each month at 5:30PM.

The Economic Development Committee meets on the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of each month at 6:30pm.

The Water Board meets on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of each month at 4:30pm as needed.

The Tree Committee meets on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of each month at 6:00pm.

The Recreation Advisory Board meets on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of each month at 6:00pm.

The Land Use Appeal Authority meets only "as needed" and will advertise their meetings in advance per State law.

### **2020 CENSUS IS COMING IN APRIL-TIME TO START TALKING ABOUT IT**



This is one of the most important functions of government. Having a correct count of all Enoch residents affects our representation in the US Congress and federal funding the State receives for many things including roads and infrastructure. Census information is private and protected for 70 years. There is no citizenship question and all need to be counted. This year will be the first year the form can be filled out online. You can also fill out a paper form if you prefer. If an address is not heard from, a Census Taker will be coming by to help you. We will be providing more information and can help you with questions.



## **SNOW REMOVAL POLICY**



When two (2") or more inches of snow has accumulated on the roads the plows are activated. The school bus routes are plowed first followed by the main roads and then the neighborhood streets. Please be mindful of the weather and remove vehicles from the road ways so the plows are able to make a clean sweep. The plows can't maneuver in cul-de-sacs if cars are parked on the road so please remind your neighbors to move cars when snow is predicted.
