

NOXIOUS WEEDS



It is every landowner's responsibility to keep their land clean and free from "noxious weeds". The most prevalent "noxious weeds" in our area are thistle and white top. If you see these in Enoch City or have any questions, please call the City Office at 435-586-1119. Weed spray for noxious weeds is available at the City Maintenance Yard on 600 East. Bring your own sprayer filled half full of water. Spray will be given out at 8:00 am and again at 4:00 pm when the public works crew is at the Maintenance Yard. The spray will only be effective on young, small weeds. If they are larger, cutting them down and disposing of them would be of the greatest service to stop the spread of seeds.

MESSAGE FROM UDOT ON SR-130 PROJECT

PUPGRADED UPDATE

UPOHADED UPOATE

Thank you for your input at our recent Open House for the SR-130; Cedar City to Midvalley Road Project. Based on community input, the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) has decided to modify the original plans and add 4' shoulders to each side of SR-130 from 3000 North through the Midvalley Road intersection. These changes will promote Active Transportation and require additional funds and time to design. The UDOT Right of Way Division is currently working with property owners near the proposed roundabout at the intersection of SR-130 and Midvalley Road. This detailed process has been impacted by the 'Stay at Home, Stay Safe' initiative but progress is being made. Due to these developments, major construction on this project will begin in spring 2021. In summer 2020, utility work will be done in preparation for this project. A separate UDOT Project to remove 2" of existing asphalt and place new asphalt pavement from Canyon Ranch Drive to 3000 North on SR-130 and on I-15 from exit 62 to Summit will begin later this spring. This project will also upgrade access tie-ins, shoulders, bridge rehabilitation, signage and other improvements. Both projects are funded entirely by UDOT and not Enoch City.
